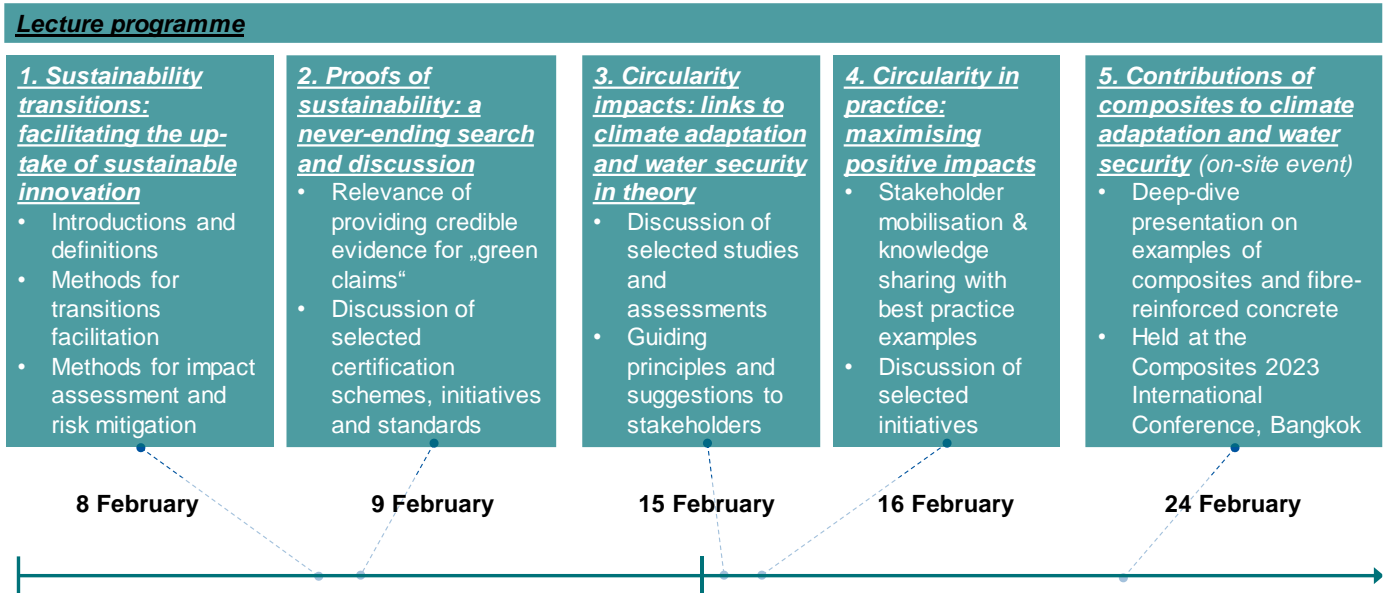


Circular economy for climate adaptation and water security – lecture series overview
